Multi-Gyn LiquiGel is based on the patented 2QR-complex that neutralizes harmful bacteria in a safe and natural way. It is therefore also suitable to support the natural healing process of tissue damages in the intimate area (e.g. after childbirth or after an operation). Multi-Gyn LiquiGel optimizes the condition of the vaginal tissue, reduces swelling and helps to prevent infection.

The formulation is natural, safe and gentle because it is not based on toxic substances or harsh chemicals and therefore it does not have negative side-effects. This unique self-care product is ideal for relief of vaginal dryness caused by e.g. sexual intercourse, hormonal changes, medication, stress or insertion of tampons. It is an excellent lubricant and has a strong soothing effect. Multi-Gyn LiquiGel combines a unique combination of properties. It has been developed by BioClin in consultation with gynecologists, GP's and specialized laboratories. The product is specifically a self-care product to relief dryness and restore the feel of your own natural moisture. It is also an excellent lubricant, enhancing sexual pleasure and facilitating intimate contact (such as insertion of tampons). It is also suitable for professional use in clinical examinations by e.g. gynecologist and midwives. Regular application of LiquiGel reduces irritation and supports an optimal condition of the vagina.

Dosage and instructions for use

Wash your hands and apply Multi-Gyn LiquiGel with your fingertips on the labia, in and around the opening of the vagina. It can be applied anytime you like and as often as you need its comfort.

The gel does not leaves stains.

Please note! Multi-Gyn LiquiGel is an active product that is aimed at moisturizing the intimate area, conditioning and stimulating natural moisture of the tissues. As an active product Multi-Gyn LiquiGel can give you a warm, tingling feeling after application. This is completely normal and will disappear after a few minutes. We advice, when you react sensitive, to try a little bit of LiquiGel on the vaginal tissue to see how you react.

Multi-Gyn LiquiGel is not a contraceptive and contains no spermicide. However, influence on the activity of sperm cells has not been researched.

The composition of Multi-Gyn LiquiGel

LiquiGel contains over 25% of the 2QR complex. Other components are plant glycerin, the natural thickener Xanthan Gum and the natural "cell fluids" regulator (osmoregulator) Betain.

Multi-Gyn LiquiGel does not contain preservatives, hormones, silicones, ingredients of animal origin, harsh chemical substances or fragrances and is completely harmless, even when swallowed. It is not greasy, does not leave stains and is water-soluble. It does not affect tampons or condoms.

Background information:

Vaginal dryness and discomforts occur frequently

Vaginal dryness and discomfort affect over half of women in all ages and stages of life. It is especially a naturally occurring problem of women in and after their menopause because of the hormonal changes.

It is also the second most common discomfort of all sexually active women. Many women first notice their vaginal dryness when intercourse becomes uncomfortable, even painful. It can undermine self-confidence, moods and interfere with normal daily activities and cause a general sense of discomfort.

The causes of vaginal dryness

The most common cause is a decrease in natural vaginal fluids due to hormonal changes, such as in the second half of the menstrual cycle or linked to menopause. But there are many other factors as well that can cause or increase the problem, such as: use of hormonal contraceptives or certain medications, soap, tampons, stress, fatigue, pregnancy and childbirth, and also intercourse without proper lubrication by your natural fluids or a suitable product such as LiquiGel.
